



## Malta Documentation Checklist

Malta boasts stunning landscapes with gorgeous beaches and historic sites. The previous residency program, MRVP, was launched in 2015 and recently updated in 2021, now known as the Malta Permanent Residence Programme (MPRP) directed by a new agency called Residency Malta Agency. Successful applicants are able to obtain residency within 6-8 months and eventual EU Citizenship.

### Children Under 18:

- Passport
- Birth Certificate
- Clean national police report (from the country of birth, citizenship, residency) for children over 12—original, valid for 6 months
